

**JOHN M. BRENNAN & KEVEN ZIEGLER
RECEIVE LICENSING AS
LICENSED SITE REMEDIATION PROFESSIONALS**

Brennan Environmental is pleased to announce that John M. Brennan, President, and Keven Ziegler, Senior Project Manager, have both received authorization as a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (“LSRP”) pursuant to the New Jersey Site Remediation Reform Act (“Reform Act”). The LSRP is a newly created license that gives environmental consultants the ability to not only complete site remediation but also issue what is known as a Response Action Outcome (RAO), which is the equivalent of a NJDEP No Further Action Letter (NFAL).

John Brennan states, “The benefit to responsible parties is the Reform Act has completely removed the NJDEP from the remediation process requiring responsible parties to utilize a LSRP to commence and complete remediation and issue an RAO, which can now be accomplished in a fraction of the time it took to obtain an NFAL under the old NJDEP review process.”

While the Reform Act has many aspects, the major impacts to responsible parties of contaminated sites are:

- it requires all new cases to be completed by a LSRP;
- allows parties that have existing cases pending review at the NJDEP to remove their case and have it completed by a LSRP;
- specifies mandatory timeframes for completion of work.
